

Fox Patchwork Applique by Dana at Waterpenny.net

1. Print out three page applique template and tape together.
2. Trace image onto fusible webbing – be sure to REVERSE the image for tracing onto the fusible webbing – i.e. if you want the fox to be facing left, in the traced image, the fox needs to be facing right.
3. Cut out 35 3” squares
4. Lay out as desired and assemble 5x7 patchwork block of 3” squares. Press carefully. You may wish to press seams open for a flatter finish.
5. Using manufacturer’s instructions, apply the fusible webbing to the back side of the patchwork. I use Pellon Wonder Under.
6. Cut out along the edge of the drawing you have made on the fusible webbing. Discard extra.
7. When you are ready to applique your fox, make sure your quilt top is carefully press. Apply the fox according to fusible webbing manufacturer’s instructions.
8. You can use a zig zag stitch or straight stitch to secure the edges. I use a straight stitch during the quilting phase to secure the fox.
